Hillel II in 358 A.D. changed God's Holydays using mathematics (which is sometimes wrong by 1-2 days early or late), instead of counting from God's New Moon. We MUST walk as Jesus walked and we simply MUST follow the Bible or else we are NOT Christians. Do NOT let anyone lie to you by saying there is no Sacred Calendar or that we are not commanded to sight the New Moons because we use: THE BIBLE USES THE WORD HODESH for moon which is derived from the root H.D.SH. meaning "new". The Crescent New Moon is called Hodesh because it is the first time the moon is SEEN anew. Again because the Crescent moon is SEEN anew it is called Hodesh. The Bible states: "He created the moon for Mo'adim (appointed times). Calendars are wrong by 1-2 days= the moon MUST be used for appointed times to obey God.
